- The Bible describes our lost condition pretty vividly. Let me read some of these instances: I
 am born an enemy of God (Rom. 5:10) For if when we were enemies we were reconciled to
 God through the death of His Son, much more, having been reconciled, we shall be saved by
 His life.
- I am born into a world of lies, and in bondage to them (Gal. 4:3-4) Even so we, when we were children, were in bondage under the elements of the world. 4 But when the fullness of the time had come, God sent forth His Son, born of a woman, born under the law
- I am a slave to sin (Rom. 6:5-6) For if we have been united together in the likeness of His death, certainly we also shall be in the likeness of His resurrection, 6 knowing this, that our old man was crucified with Him, that the body of sin might be done away with, that we should no longer be slaves of sin.
